

# PUZZLE OF MYSTERY CORN CIRCLES

In the quiet of a Hampshire field, the phenomenon of precise circles of flattened corn which has been puzzling scientists for more than a decade has appeared again.

The mysterious circle in the wheatfield at the Devil's Punchbowl, near Winchester, measures 68 feet in diameter and is bounded by another ring four feet wide, five feet from the circle's outer edge.

Over the years, the circles which appear in several parts of England and overseas, have been said to be caused by visits from space, freak weather conditions, druid ceremonies or electro-magnetic fields.
