The Saucer Pilot in a Plastic Bag

PARIS, Friday.
MORE and more mysterious objects were reported to day as France's "Spot the flying saucer" season continued in full swing.

Police received reports of a cigar-shaped object surrounded by a dozen smaller cigars and a bright red luminous object with things like sticks standing up all round it."

And three "flying saucer" pilots were said to have landed—one in a plastic bag, the second dressed like a deep-sea diver and the third wearing a kind of suit.

All arrived in luminous unidentified machines.

The plastic pilot—the pilot of a boy—was reported by M. Leboeuf, of Drome.

"At first I thought it was a new type of plastic scarecrow," she said. "But when it moved towards me I ran and hid behind a hedge."

She said the man got back into his "saucer" and took off mysteriously. "It sounded like a musical top," she said.

The man in the diver-type of dress was reported by Yves Davignon, farmer of Montcu. He said the man touched his arms and said something to him in an unintelligible language.
