## French see more flying saucers<sup>13A</sup>

Little men from Mars prefer France to any other country for their earthly visits, according to the growing band of flying saucer observers. They claim that the skies over France have become congested with saucers, cigars and flying discs swooping to earth with their heavenly guests, says Reuter.

The latest report came from the village of Vron, Northern France, where two youths "stumbled across a flying saucer" as they returned home from work. They said the machine, looking like a millstone, lay in the middle of the road. "Strange little men" were clustered around it, but immediately they drew near, the saucer took off and disappeared over the horizon.

A "moon-shaped" machine of a type which has never been sighted in France before, touched down near Lusignac according to another report yesterday. Five inhabitants say they saw it on the ground for a few minutes before it rose vertically into the air and disappeared.

Although the saucer pilots are reported to be shy, several have been seen and even approached, according to Frenchmen in various country towns and villages.
